The Birmingham Farmers Market Returns this Season with New Events, Activities, Vendors and More!

BIRMINGHAM, MI, April 16, 2024 – The Birmingham Farmers Market returns for the season with new events and activities, a record number of vendors, and a brand new logo! The market opens for the season on Sunday, May 5 with its annual Opening Day Celebration featuring live music, kids' activities and free reusable tote bags (while supplies last).

The bustling outdoor market draws thousands of visitors each season to shop local produce and artisan goods, listen to live music and gather with family and friends. The market is open every Sunday, May 5 through October 27, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m., and is located in Public Parking Lot 6 at 660 North Old Woodward Avenue in downtown Birmingham.
